Champagnes

- 100 **MOËT CHANDON IMPERIAL NV** France **110**
Palate is delicate well-balanced, creamy and rich. There are unlimited fragrances and nuances that lead into the broad palate, filling the tongue with highlights and leaving behind a sense of harmony, mellowness.
A medium bodied Champagne with generous fruit and toasted flavors, supple on the palate with a lingering rich finish.
- 101 **VEUVE CLICQUOT PONSARDIN BRUT NV** France **115**
Very fine bubbles in an attractive yellow-gold wine. Lovely nose of clean fruit and yeasty bread. The palate follows the nose, with tasty notes of pear, citrus and buttered toast. This Champagne will give you a lingering finish.
- 102 **MOËT & CHANDON DOM PERIGNON 2000** France **295**
Fresh and sharp on the nose, notes of licorice and dried ginger linger on the skins of pear and mango.
The finish gradually unfurls and then settles smooth, mellow, all encompassing.
- 103 **VEUVE CLICQUOT LA GRANDE DAME 1996** France **295**
Dominant floral notes mingle with hints of fresh fruit. In the mouth, Pinot Noir reveals its true personality.
The balance between freshness and vigor is ideal. A clean and persistent finish.
- 104 **KRUG 1995** France **295**
Extremely expressive with very elegant notes of hazelnut and macadamia. The wine has explosive aromas and flavors of peach, orange peel, honey and smoke. Dense, chewy and solid.
- 105 **LOUIS ROEDERER CRISTAL 2000** France **550**
This classically - styled, dry Champagne is blend of two-thirds black grapes.
Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier for body, balanced with one-third Chardonnay for elegance.
- 106 **ARMAND DE BRIGNAC ACE OF SPADES NV** France **700**
Extraordinary refinement and distinction... the mouth is overwhelmed by a series of shades
Brought together in perfect symphony abundant and seductive.
A perfect balance of sweetness and acidity.

Sparkling Wines

- 126 **NAVARRO CORREAS BRUT MALBEC NV** Argentina **46**
Deep, translucent ruby color. Bold strawberry jam on warm buttered toast and warm flan aromas follow through on a round, frothy entry to a fruity medium-full body with lots of depth and a spicy, lightly peppery cherry butter and blood orange accented fade.
- 127 **GLORIA FERRER BLANC DE NOIR NV** Sonoma California USA **65**
Round and full-bodied, with rich, ripe apple, pear and honeydew melon flavors this complex sparkler has a nice touch of yeast and doughy aromas that gives it added character, turning creamy with a touch of Vanilla.

Blush Wines & Rose

- 136 **SUTTERHOME WHITE ZINFANDEL 2009** California USA **40**
A delicate blush pink color introduces this fresh, lively wine. On your palate, light creaminess surrenders to a refreshing crisp finish of strawberries and melon.
- 137 **BERINGER WHITE ZINFANDEL 2009** California USA **39**
This pretty wine has a balanced, bright fruitiness that coats your mouth and carries through to the back with a crispness that ties everything together.
- 138 **BARTON & GUESTIER ROSE D'ANJOU 2009** Loire France **44**
Raspberry pink in color. Fine and expressive nose, dominated by fruit drop aromas strawberry and raspberry and floral notes. Harmonious and well-balanced wine, with pleasant round attack and nice freshness due to high acidity. Fresh and aromatic finish.

Pinot Grigio

- 201 **SANTA MARGHERITA 2010** Alto Adige Italy **46**
This dry white wine is pale straw-yellow in color. The clean, intense aroma and dry flavor with pleasant golden apple aftertaste make Santa Margherita Pinot Grigio a wine of great character and versatility.
- 202 **BOLLINI RISERVA 2006** Trentino Italy **54**
Fresh and delicate, this wine shows clean stone fruit and apple flavors, a crisp, balanced acidic structure.
- 203 **LIVIO FELLUGA 2007** Napa Valley USA **70**
The nose of tropical fruits, rose petals and tulips is almost enticing enough to dab behind the ears. Full and fresh in the mouth with great acidity, it finishes with lingering flavors of mango, apple and bananas.

Sauvignon Blanc

- 226 **MONTES ALPHA 2009** Colchagua Valley Chile **39**
Full, intense gooseberry nose. Ripe, quiet sweet, semi peachy palate is rich grassy and fruity
- 227 **GOLDEN KAAAN 2009** Western Cape South Africa **38**
A lively wine with fresh tropical fruit flavors. The freshness is further complemented by well balanced and complex flavors on the palate.
- 229 **NOBILO 2009** Marlborough New Zealand **46**
With fresh flavors of gooseberry, peach and tropical fruits. The palate has excellent weight with crisp, balanced acidity and a lengthy finish.
- 230 **SIMI 2009** Sonoma USA **50**
This wine offer elegance and richness, Crisp cleaning acidity. Delicate citrus flavors and a silky mouth feel that make it a perfect wine
- 232 **GROTH 2006/2009** Sonoma USA **75**
A Sauvignon Blanc with silky texture. An underlying spice from Chalk Hill soil supports the layers of citrus, melon and pear found in this wine.
- 234 **DE LADOUCETTE, POUILLY-FUME 2001** Loire France **85**
It has an exceptional full range of floral, exotic and citrus fruit, with mineral undertones, and a finish that brings to mind a pleasant lemony freshness.

Chardonnay

- 300 **VERAMONTE RESERVE 2007** Casablanca Chile **45**
Sumptuous, ripe tropical fruit flavors, with solid balance of bright vibrant fruit and refreshing acidity subtle oak and warm spice round out the middle.
- 301 **MONTES ALPHA 2006** Casablanca Chile **39**
Fermented and aged in French Oak barrels for 1 year, using a monthly batonage to enhance buttery flavor and complexity that emphasizes the union of refined flavors of tropical fruit.
- 304 **LINDEMANS BIN 65 2008** Australia **38**
The bouquet offers melon, stone fruit and the barest hint of oak. The palate is well balanced, with a touch of creaminess and moderate fruit intensity.
- 308 **RODNEY STRONG 2007** Alexander Valley California USA **42**
Bright lemon and apple aromas mingle with hints of toasty barrel complexity on the palate, pear and pineapple with spice and refreshing acidity will back for another glass.
- 309 **KENDALL JACKSON 2009** California USA **59**
Fresh aromas of citrus, butterscotch and lemon peel open to appealing hints of jasmine and nutmeg. On the palate, rich butter cream, pear and citrus meld to create a plush, rounded middle, with toast and caramel adding richness and texture to the long lingering finish.
- 310 **SEQUOIA GROVE 2000** Napa Valley USA **68**
100% fermented to enhance texture. This is elegant and complex with a smooth, silky texture on the palate and good balance of rich fruit and oak.
- 312 **STAGS' LEAP 2008** Napa Valley USA **75**
Ripe Apricot and Pear flavors lead into a luscious mid palate with a pretty mineral tinged structure.
- 314 **CUVAISON 2004** Napa Valley USA **79**
Elegant, aromatic with layers of pineapple and vanilla oak. Medium body with balanced oak and acidity in the finish.
- 315 **MER SOLEIL BARREL FERMENTED 2004** California USA **98**
A ripe, opulent style, with apple, citrus, pineapple, and butterscotch tones. Accented by spicy, oak and hints of hazelnut.
- 316 **GRGICH HILLS 2005** Napa Valley USA **95**
Big, bold, buttery with citrus interwoven and a crisp youthful aftertaste. A Napa classic.
- 320 **LOUIS JADOT POUILLY-FUISSE 2008** Burgundy France **75**
Ripe, supple and of medium body, this classic expression of Pouilly-Fuissé shows vibrant Chardonnay fruit flavors with notes of melon and minerals, gently touched with oak, ending in a fresh, silky finish.

Riesling

- 276 **CHÂTEAU STE. MICHELLE 2009** Washington USA **46**
A long cool fermentation preserves the crispness of our wine and enhances the peach, ripe apricot and citrus flavors.
- 277 **EROICA 2008** Washington USA **60**
A classic Riesling, with tangy citrus and floral undertones, finishing with refreshing acidity. A joint venture of Ste. Michelle and German producer Dr. Loosen. America's best Riesling.
- 279 **FRITZ HAAG JUFFER SONNENUHR SPÄTLESE 2009** Germany **60**
There is a delight full, pure and bright style here, showing a gentle character endowed with honey and pear fruit. Pure, defined, light footed, elegant and balanced. But underneath it has depth and a great acid backbone and a great length too.

Innovative Whites

- 352 **MENAGE A' TROIS 2005/2009** California USA **46**
Ménage a' Trois white marries Chardonnay, Muscat, and Chenin Blanc. Each variety is individually harvest, gently crushed and cold-fermented in small stainless steel tanks to preserve and retain the juicy fruit aromas.
- 353 **CONUNDRUM 2008** California USA **72**
A rich and harmonious blend of tropical fruits, with floral aromatics. The fruit and floral notes give a perceived sweetness to this dry wine. Blend of: Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon, Muscat and Viognier.

Pinot Noir

- 401 **WILD ROCK 2008** Marlborough New Zealand **65**
Deep garnet color with purple highlights, the Rancho Santa Rosa Pinot Noir has aromas of black cherry, blackberry and blueberry. There are also earth notes of mushroom, Black tea and smoked meats.
- 402 **CUVAISON 2008** Carneros USA **82**
Aromas of red Raspberry, Black Cherry, Smoky leather and allspice. A rich palate with integrated tannins. Flavors of damson plum, spice and orange peel, with long finish.
- 403 **TORRES MARIMAR ESTATE 2005** Carneros USA **92**
Aromas of wild berries, truffle and an array of spices, nutmeg, clove, cinnamon, anise. The palate shows excellent structure and a well developed body, with firm tannins and a trace of vanilla and toast from the noble ageing in oak.
- 407 **LOUIS JADOT 2006** Burgundy France **60**
Harmonious and balanced, with a plump fruitiness and silky texture offset by round, gentle tannins in a wine of medium body and elegant structure. The very typical, fragrant varietal bouquet is complemented by a delicious, lingering finish.

Merlot

- 451 **MARQUES DE CASA CONCHA 2007** Maipo Valley Chile **44**
Ripe and lush, with lots of blackberry, plum, and mocha and vanilla flavors plus the velvety finish is loaded with fruit and a hint of grilled herb.
- 452 **CASA LA POSTOLE 2006** Cuvee Alexandre Merlot- Rapel Valley Chile **64**
Powerful and deep with good structure, the wine is soft and chewy with a long and pleasant finish.
- 453 **LUIGI BOSCA RESERVE 2004** Argentina **38**
Round and full wine, with ripe black and red berries aromas. Deep purple in color, it is a pleasant wine with an unctuous finish. French oak barrel aging provides great structure to this wine.
- 454 **ROSEMOUNT 2008** Australia **47**
Richly textured and well defined ripe black berry fruit flavors, soft and generous tannins on the mid-palate and a long, rich finish
- 458 **COPPOLA 2008** Napa Valley USA **60**
Deep indigo color, and a palate loaded with intense raspberries, plums and currant flavor. Soft and easy drinking, with medium body.
- 459 **KENDALL JACKSON VINTNER'S RESERVE 2008** California USA **50**
Aromas and flavors of plum and black cherry are complemented by toasty vanilla oak in this medium-bodied wine.
- 460 **STERLING VINTNER'S COLLECTION 2005** Sonoma County USA **60**
Smooth and rich in flavor, with black currant, spice and toast nutty flavor, with a soft full finish.
- 461 **FERRARI CARANO 2006** Sonoma USA **72**
Elegant and medium bodied this special wine displays rich, concentrated fruit with well-rounded tannins.

Malbec

- 501 **TRAPICHE BROQUEL 2006** Argentina **35**
Great aromas of crushed blueberry and raspberry, with juicy texture and well-integrated toast and mineral notes.
- 502 **CATENA 2008** Mendoza Argentina **50**
Great aromas of crushed blueberry and raspberry, with juicy texture and well-integrated toast and mineral notes.
- 503 **LUIGI BOSCA DOC 2007** Mendoza Argentina **38**
Deep Violet red. Aromas of cherries and ripe plum. Spicy, hints of honey figs and blackberry.

Shiraz/Syrah

- 576 **MARQUES DE CASA CONCHA SYRAH 2006** Rapel Chile **40**
Offering solid blackberry and cherry flavors. At the end a lasting smoky yet rich black tar. Firm in texture, with a fine grained tannins supporting bright fruit.
- 577 **HARDY'S SHIRAZ 2009** Western Australia **39**
This wine is deep colored and tannic, with strong tar, spice and pepper qualities. Blackberries, blackcurrants and plums with hints of smokiness.
- 578 **PENFOLDS THOMAS HIGHLAND SHIRAZ 2005** South East Australia **55**
A concentrated and rich Aussie Shiraz, with lots of ripe berry fruit, smoke and gamy spice.

Cabernet Sauvignon

- 526 **MONTES ALPHA 2007** Apalta Valley Chile **38**
Deep ruby red color, the expression of Cabernet Sauvignon is evident providing structure and elegance. Lots of berries fruits and hints of tobacco and vanilla. Promising abundant soft rounded tannins.
- 529 **MARQUES DE CASA CONCHA 2006** Maipo Valley Chile **42**
Marques de Casa Concha Cabernet Sauvignon is an outstanding dark ruby red wine with bell pepper, smoke and eucalyptus aromas. It is an appetizing, smooth, well-rounded and tasteful wine. Black currants flavors, well-balanced with a long finish.
- 531 **LUIGI BOSCA RESERVA 2004** Argentina **38**
Brilliant cherry red, clean, fresh, fruity, velvety good body. Aromas of red fruit, strawberries, violets and chocolate. A vigorous attractive wine, combining strength and firmness with delicacy and elegance.
- 534 **RUST EN VREDE CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2007** Stellenbosch South Africa **75**
Cherry and chocolate aromas backed up by hints of spice from the French oak a very elegant wine with huge tannin structure, lovely fruit. This spice oriented Cabernet Sauvignon is supported by chocolate tobacco and aniseed flavors on the palate.
- 537 **RODNEY STRONG 2005** Alexander Valley USA **65**
Blackberry, red currant and fresh earth are core flavors with crown, and are accented by hints of mint and herbs.
- 538 **SIMI 2007** Sonoma USA **69**
Upfront berry aromas with a hint of sweet oak, elegant tannins, black spice and a lingering finish.
- 539 **CUVAISON 2004** Napa Valley USA **89**
A dark concentrated wine that is both elegant and polished, with aromas of black cherry cocoa and dark roasted coffee. Good structure on the palate with integrated flavors off plum, espresso and hints of all spice.
- 540 **KENDALL JACKSON VINTNER'S RESERVE 2008** California USA **55**
the velvety structure of the wine reveals deep flavor of cassis and dark fruit with a touch of oak light tannins.

Zinfandel

- 600 **RANCHO ZABACO ZINFANDEL 2007/2008** Sonoma USA **45**
The wine is immediately approachable with bold spice and big blackberry fruit and a hint of black pepper with soft, rich mouth feel.
- 601 **SEGHEISIO ZINFANDEL 2007** Sonoma USA **58**
"Shows" robust black cherry and spice aromas and blackberry jam and licorice flavors the tannins firm's up the finish.
- 602 **ROSENBLUM 2005** California **62**
On the nose it is mostly cedar, black pepper and plum. The palate is predominantly big blackberry flavor and raisin. The finish brings a touch of raspberry and a snappy spice giving this wine a nice complexity. The tannins are fine grained.

Interesting Reds

- 700 **CASILLERO DEL DIABLO RESERVA PRIVADA 2007** Rapel Chile **38**
Deep and luxurious, intense and brilliant ruby red, blackcurrant, red cherry, blackberry and plum
65% Cabernet Sauvignon & 35% Syrah.
- 701 **TERRUNYO CARMÈNERE 2005** Rapel Valley Chile **56**
Dark and deep red with violet nuances. Very elegant, complex, strong character of Carmeniere red ripe fruit, spicy with hints of tobacco. Great structure, mouth filling, sour chocolate sweet tannins, powerful and concentrated.
- 721 **PEPPOLI CHIANTI CLASSICO 2008** Italy **65**
Deep ruby red in color with garnet tones, rich in extracts and tannic yet balanced soft and stylish with a fine, lingering finish.
65% Sangiovese, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot.
- 722 **CASTELLO BANFI CHIANTI CLASSICO RISERVA 2007** Italy **55**
This Chianti Classico exemplifies a modern approach to making this very traditional wine. It's a satisfying middleweight with good flavor intensity and well-balanced structure.
- 732 **TINTO PESQUERA CRIANZA 2003** Ribera Del Duero Spain **60**
The first of a wave of new Spanish producers, to make fresh, lively fruit forward world class wines. Medium body, bright fruit.
- 741 **ROSEMOUNT ESTATE GSM 2006** Australia **75**
This premium McLaren vale wine typically combines spicy flavors with the opulent fruit and firm structure.
50% Grenache, 40% Syrah, 10% Mourvedre.
- 751 **MENAGE A' TROIS 2008** California USA **48**
A saucy tease that brings blackberry and pepper spice with its generous mouth feel and round texture. The rich flavors and firm tannins of this wine make it ideal candidate for the bottom layer of the trio; Zinfandel, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon.
- 761 **MONT REDON CÔTE DU RHONE 2006** Rhône France **48**
An earthy, rustic blend of dark berry fruit, spice and moderate oak and tannic. 50% Grenache, 50% Syrah.

Reserve Wines

CHILE

- 530 **CONCHA Y TORO, DON MELCHOR 1996/2005** Puente Alto -Cabernet **145**
This is still very tight, but the tannins that lead the way now are sleek and refined, and should easily meld into the huge core of roasted chestnut, black currant paste, warm fig and tar. Has a long, coffee -and loam- tinged finish.
- 702 **ALMAVIVA 2001** Puente Alto –Interesting Blend **185**
This wine shows plenty of Pauillac, dried currant and cigar smoke, also gas layers of Chilean loam, blackberry, plum, spice and minerals. Cabernet Sauvignon, Carmenère and Cabernet Franc.

ARGENTINA

- 505 **TERRAZAS DE LOS ANDES AFINCADO 2006** Malbec **125**
A polished, modern style, with creamy layers of mocha and spice covering almost exotically ripe plum and blackberry fruit.
- 579 **TWO HANDS BELLA'S GARDEN SHIRAZ 2007** Barrosa Valley Australia **140**
A lifted bouquet of ripe cherry, tar, mint, and bitter chocolate. Firm and juicy, with tannins that are drying and mouth-filling.

SPAIN

- 802 **RODA RESERVA 2003** Duero-Interesting Red **225**
Plush yet focused, this round red shows plum, raisin, cinnamon, cedar and black pepper flavors. The tannins are still quite firm, balanced by fresh acidity.

ITALY

- 800 **CASTELLO BANFI POGGIO ALL 'ORO 1999** -Interesting Red **225**
Blackberry and blue berry aromas are focused and ultraclean. Full-bodied, with deep core of pretty fruit and polished tannins. Closed and tight right now, but will open into something very special indeed.

FRANCE

- 235 **DE LADoucETTE BARON DE L POUILLY-FUME 2001** Loire **185**
Intense citrus, pear, mineral and floral honey aromas, with a hint of baking spices full and ripe but also focused, with pure citrus and orchard fruit flavors brightened by tangy mineral notes and deepened by a suggestion of sweet butter.
- 321 **LOUIS JADOT PULIGNY MONTRACHET 2001/2004** -Burgundy **110**
The wine is rich and opulent with a focused "taste of the region". The typical flavor of the wine is buttery rich, with a spicy exotic fruit character and a crisp balancing acidity.
- 762 **CHATEAU DE JABOULET Rhône-Interesting Red 95**
CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE 2006
Dark ruby/purple in color with fruit, herb and spice aromas, complex rich flavor with spicy character, opulence and intensity. Grenache, Mourvèdre, Syrah, Cinsault.
- 764 **CHÂTEAU TALBOT 4ÈME CRU 2001** St. Julienne Bordeaux-Interesting Red **125**
One of the most consistent and undervalued wines of Bordeaux. The wine is a complex balanced of black cherry and cassis, framed with sweet oak, firm tannins and a focused finish.
Cabernet, Cabernet Franc, Merlot.
- 803 **CHÂTEAU LA TOUR PAUILLAC 1986** Bordeaux-Interesting Red **700**
. The vintages of La Tour wines are rich, fruity, spicy with minty and mineral aromas and remarkably concentrated with the tight tannins
- 805 **CHATEAU COS D'ESTOURNEL 2004** Bordeaux-Interesting Red **595**
Gorgeous aromas of currants and berries with hints of licorice. Full-bodied, with velvety tannins and a pretty finish. Silky. This is extremely good for the vintage.
- 806 **CHATEAU LYNCH BAGES PAUILLAC 2003** Bordeaux-Interesting Red **700**
Deep, slightly smoky, rather dusty dried red-fruit character here. Perfumed too, fairly bright and lifted. A gently composed palate, elegant, with a gentle presence of fruit, good structure beneath, perhaps a slight coarseness to it but the tannins are at least ripe.
- 807 **CHATEAU LA MISSION HAUT-BRION 1995** Bordeaux-Interesting Red **340**
The powerful nose begins with notes of wood toasted bread and a perceptible sweetness. In the mouth the equilibrium of this wine is surprising with much mellowness, softness and harmony. The fruit is both supple and tender as it dominates the solid, ripe tannin.

Reserve Wines

USA

- 317 **CHALK HILL 2005** Sonoma -Chardonnay **95**
Chalk Hill Chardonnay features mineral, citrus, floral and tropical fruit notes.
- 318 **CAKEBREAD CELLARS 2006/2008** Napa Valley - Chardonnay **175**
An exceptionally harmonious wine with aromas of pears, apples and lemon, intense flavors of vanilla and rich toasty oak notes.
- 319 **FAR NIENTE 2005** Napa Valley -Chardonnay **155**
Smooth, buttery and complex with an elegant core of citrus, pear and butter scotch, woven into rich oak and balancing acidity.
- 462 **STAGS' LEAP 2006** Napa Valley-Merlot **110**
Merlot Vines grow exceptionally in the Bale Loam's of Stags' Leap. Careful vineyard selection followed by meticulous farming yields. A Merlot with rich fruits flavors, full body, and firm structure.
- 463 **DUCKHORN 2003** Napa Valley-Merlot **145**
Napa's premier Merlot producer. Dense and concentrated wines showing black cherry, vanilla, herbs and sweet oak. The wines always drink well young, as well as aging extremely well.
- 809 **DUCKHORN THREE PALMS 2005** Napa Valley - Merlot **225**
This concentrated wine has velvety texture, bright acidity, and firm, well-integrated tannins. On the palate, the flavors are dominated by dark red fruits, including ripe strawberries and dried cherries, with inviting accents of toasted oak, chocolate, and spice
- 405 **GOLDEN EYE 2004** Anderson Valley Oregon -Pinot Noir **145**
This full-bodied wine has lofty weight yet the wine is supple, elegant and well-balanced. The flavors are dominated by blueberry, plum, blackberry, and a medley of spices, including clove, cinnamon, and nutmeg.
- 406 **DOMAINE DROUHIN LAURENE 2005** Willamette Valley Oregon -Pinot Noir **150**
The wine offers a delightful aromatic bouquet, which shows a kaleidoscope of fruits, spices and flowers.
- 808 **WILLIAMS SELYEM 2004** Russian River Valley -Pinot Noir **130**
One of California's first cult wines, and to his day one of the truly great Pinot Noirs of the world. This wine is still highly allocated and very difficult to find.
- 752 **MERRYVALE PROFILE 2004** Napa Valley - Blend **188**
An opulently structured Bordeaux blend, with a complex mix of dark berry fruit, Smokey oak and well-integrated tannins. A vintage the winemaker prefers over 1997.- 59% Cabernet, 35% Merlot, 4% Petit Verdot, 2% Cabernet Franc.
- 316 **GRGICH HILLS 2005** Napa Valley -Cabernet **95**
Berries and plum characteristic with a trace of the earthiness in the bouquet
- 540 **STAGS' LEAP CELLARS 2006** Napa Valley -Cabernet **120**
Ripe fruit aromas of black cherry, cloves and cedar flavors of tobacco and tea and ripe fruit. Full-bodied with a firm structure and a rich finish with hints of blackberry and cinnamon.
- 541 **JORDAN 2005** Sonoma -Cabernet **125**
One of California's most consistent producers. Always complex, with great structure and balanced fruit and oak.
- 542 **DUCKHORN 2006** Napa Valley -Cabernet **145**
The bouquet has components of cherry, toasty oak, plums and cassis. The flavors are lush and reminiscent of black berries and lavender.
- 543 **CAKEBREAD CELLARS 2006** Napa Valley -Cabernet **155**
Full bodied and deeply colored wine with aromas of blackberry cherry, well developed notes of plums and elegant herbal over notes.
- 331 **SILVER OAK CELLARS 2003/2004** Alexander Valley -Cabernet **180**
A wine of extraordinary intensity and depth. It has a very dark garnet color and concentrated nose of cassis, roasting coffee, Chocolate, violets and sandalwoods. Extremely rich on the palate, with a full-bodied structure and a long fruity intense finish.
- 810 **2480 HOLLYWOOD & VINE 2002** California - Cabernet **180**
The finished wine accentuates it is bold multi-faceted origins. Ripe wild plums dominate the aromas, while toasty spice and vanilla tones compliment the mouth filling purple fruit character.
- 811 **JOSEPH PHELPS INSIGNIA 2000** Napa Valley -Cabernet **250**
Deftly balanced, with dark color and rich fruit. Elegant, with tiers of currant, mocha blackberry and espresso beans. Firms up at mid-palate and flexes, its tannic strength on the finish.
- 812 **SILVER OAK CELLARS 2002/2004** Napa Valley -Cabernet **275**
A deep, rich Cabernet Sauvignon with a garnet color and a concentrated touch of cocoa, cassis syrup, coffee, and black licorice. It is extremely full - bodied on the palate.
- 813 **FAR NIENTE 1998** Napa Valley -Cabernet **275**
Tight, complex and concentrated, with a pretty core of spicy currant, anise, sage and cedar, turning supple and harmonious on the finish.
- 814 **OPUS ONE 2005/2006** Napa Valley -Cabernet **410**
Aromas of black currant, black cherry liqueur, plum and fresh vanilla, with hints of graham cracker and black peppercorn. A supple, creamy entry is followed by intense flavors of ripe black cherry, cassis and dark chocolate, finishing with a lingering black fruity and savory spice.
